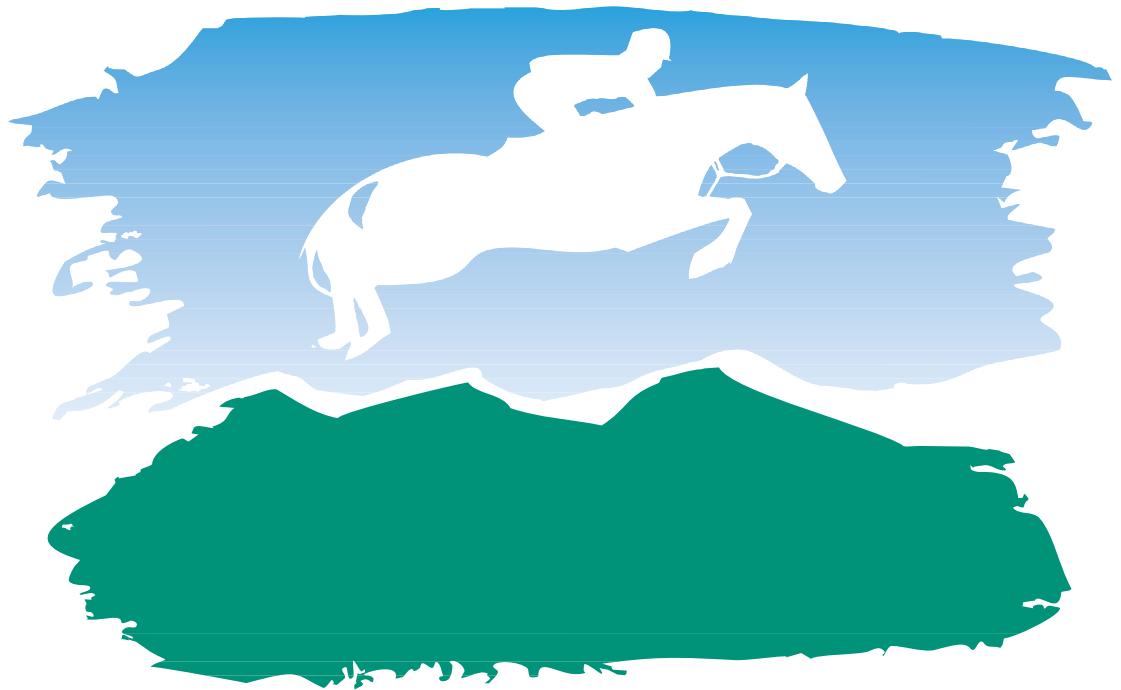

SPECIFICATIONS FOR ALL HUNTER CLASSES

Hunter Over Fences

To be shown over approximately eight fences the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

Hunter Under Saddle

To be shown at a walk, trot, canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. May be asked to hand gallop at the discretion of the judge but no more than eight to gallop at one time. Martingales not permitted. Green and non-rated hunter sections will not be asked to gallop.

Model Class

To be shown at a walk and trot on the line; to be judged on conformation, way of moving and soundness.

Champion and Reserve Champion

To be awarded to two of the four horses scoring the most points over fences. In addition, only these will receive full points for

ribbons won under saddle and half points for ribbons won in the model (full points in Regular Conformation Model.)

Courses

Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop, and panels. Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads as competition warrants.

Jogging

The following hunter sections will not be jogged: Hi-Low, Schooling, Pre-Green, Adult Amateur, Children's, Modified Junior/Amateur, Modified Child/Adult.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER – NEHC RATED C

Open to Junior Exhibitors who are eligible for Intermediate Equitation as of December 1 of the current show year. Height of fences: 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, 3' for horses, spreads not to exceed fence height. The division may be split at the discretion of show management. Same horse/pony-rider combination cannot show in any other rated division except Equitation. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division or section at the same show except Jr. Hunter. Ponies may not cross enter into the green or regular pony hunter divisions. Children's Hunter riders may not show in any class where the fence heights exceed 3'6" at the same show. 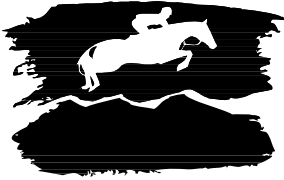

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES PROVIDED THE RESPECTIVE BREED/ DISCIPLINE DUES OR BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE HAS BEEN PAID. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$20 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE AND A \$5 BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE FOR EACH BREED/DISCIPLINE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES. ALSO EXEMPTED FROM THIS REQUIREMENT ARE CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 7) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 8) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

Vermont Summer Festival, LLC, the owners of the facilities, the shows, their officials and employees will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment of any of the above shows included in this prize list.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section, or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

GENERAL

1. ENTRY DUE DATES: Entries for weeks 1, 2 & 3 must be postmarked by June 10, 2006. Entries for weeks 4 & 5 must be postmarked by July 3, 2006. LIMITED STABLING – assigned on a first come first served basis.

2. ENTRIES: No entry will be accepted or recorded unless signed by the owner/rider(s)/trainer and the required fees in US funds accompany the entry blank. Stall fees and office fees must be sent with the entries. All accounts must be settled each week by Sunday p.m. All open checks will be filled in by Monday 12:00 noon. **Separate checks must be attached for each week's fees.**

3. ENTRY RECEIPT: Entries received by the closing date will be assessed a \$25 office fee. Entries received after the closing date will be assessed a \$50 office fee. Stalls will be on the first come basis and on a 3-1 ratio.

4. SCRATCHING/REFUND: Once entered, no horse may be scratched without a Veterinarian's certificate. In the case of illness or injury before the start of the show, the certificate must be received by the Horse Show Secretary prior to 8:00 a.m. on the opening day of the show in order to be eligible for a refund. Scratches during the show may be made only with a Veterinarian's certificate signed by the Horse Show Veterinarian and presented to the Horse Show Secretary before the start of the class the horse has been entered in. Refunds will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the final Horse Show. There will be a \$25 office charge for all refunds. Scratches by telephone will not be accepted.

5. STALLS: Stalls are approximately 10' x 10', portable, under tents, with doors. Initial bedding will not be provided. Stalls, whether occupied by horse, feed or tack will be available as follows:

Weekly Stalls: Available Monday Noon and ending 6:00 p.m. of each show week for \$175. After closing dates of entries, stall fees are NOT refundable.

Late Stalls: Any stalls ordered after the closing date will be \$200.

Weekly Paddocks: 24 x 36 pipe paddocks are available for \$250 per week, available on the first come first served basis.

For any exceptions to the above, please call (802) 496-4878.

6. FEED STORE: Hay, grain and bedding may be purchased on the grounds. For same day delivery, orders must be received prior to 12 Noon. For feed orders and deliveries prior to arrival, please call (802) 496-4878.

7. PRIZE MONEY: All prize money will be paid in the ring and duplicate checks will not be written in case of loss. All checks will be void after 60 days. Prize money awarded through 6th place. **Owners must provide a Social Security or Federal ID number.**

8. NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$25 or 10% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashier's check or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

9. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All horses must be accompanied by a record of negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia conducted within the last twelve (12) months. This certificate must show date of the negative test and the name of the approved laboratory where the test was conducted. Rabies and Potomac horse fever vaccinations are recommended.

10. LEASH LAW: Dogs and other pets must be on a leash at all times while on the show grounds. There will be a \$50 fine for any stray dog that has been impounded by the dog warden. Upon payment of the fine, the animal will be released in the owner's custody. A second impoundment of the same animal will result in the owner being barred from the show grounds.

11. MEASUREMENT CARDS: Owners of all Pony and Junior Hunters must possess a USEF measurement card. These cards must be presented to the Horse Show Secretary before start of the horse show.

12. AMATEUR CREDENTIALS: All Amateur-Owner and Adult Amateurs must present their USEF cards to the Horse Show Secretary before the start of the show.

13. DAMAGE: All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

14. TELEPHONE/MAIL: For telephone communications with Vermont Summer Festival (802) 496-4878.

15. POLING RULE: Poling or the use of offsets will not be permitted.

16. ALL MOTORIZED VEHICLES must be operated by licensed individuals.

17. NO ELECTRIC GOLF CARTS ALLOWED.

18. PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR must be worn anytime riders are mounted on the show grounds.

20. ALL RINGS AND SCHOOLING AREAS are all weather stone dust. Hunter rings are 130' x 275'; Grand Prix Field is 300' x 200'; Jumper Ring 2 is 120' x 300'; Hunter schooling areas are 80' x 250'; Jumper schooling area is 200' x 150'.

21. NON-HORSE STALLS will be limited to 3-1 ratio.

(the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition.

I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules.

I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

Entry Blank: Enter the following on the Entry Blank exactly as it is recorded with the USEF. If not, points may not count.

1. Owner Name(s) and USEF number(s)
2. Horse Name and Recording number
3. Rider Name(s) and USEF number(s)

Membership for Owners – Riders – Trainers: If you are an owner, rider or trainer, you must be a member of USEF and USHJA or pay the appropriate non-member fee and breed/discipline fee.

Affidavit – Membership: If you file an affidavit saying you are a member of USEF and USHJA and it turns out that you are not, YOU MAY BE FINED.

Affidavit – Horse Recording: If you file an affidavit saying that a horse is recorded with USEF and it turns out that your horse is not, YOU MAY BE FINED.

False Affidavit – who is responsible: The exhibitor is responsible for the signing of an affidavit even if signed by his/her agent, unless the affidavit is for a person under 18. In this case the person signing the affidavit is responsible and MAY BE FINED. The fine is \$200.

Amateur Owner or Amateur Adult: If you show in divisions restricted to amateur riders, you must be a Senior Amateur member and it must say "Amateur" on your USEF Membership card. If it does not, you must apply for Amateur Status.

Amateur Owner or Amateur Adult Non-Member: If you are a non-member of USEF and want to show in the Adult or Amateur divisions, you must pay the \$30 amateur certification fee plus the non-member fee.

Horse Recording versus Horse ID Number: Every horse must be RECORDED with USEF (\$\$) or have an ID number (FREE). Horses showing in divisions for which USEF gives points must be RECORDED in order to get points. Horses with an ID number will not get points. Horses showing in jumper classes that award prize money must be RECORDED.

Measurement Cards: Junior Hunters, Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters, and Pony Jumpers must have a Measurement Card or be measured. Owner Membership is required for Measurement unless Canadian. Canadians can apply for an ID number. Canadian passport/measurement card is not acceptable.

USEF Eventing Members: (USEA) do not have to pay breed/discipline fee to USEF and do not need to be members of USHJA.

USEF Dressage Members: (USDF) pay the \$5 breed/discipline fee to USEF (only if a Senior) and must be members of USHJA or pay the non-member fee.

Foreign Competitors – including Canadians and Mexicans: Must present to the Show Secretary proof in English that they are a member in good standing of their National Federation or be/become a USEF member.
